ISLE OF MAN ART SOCIETY SUMMER ART EXHIBITION - Braddan Church Halls

We are excited that this year's exhibition (even though rescheduled) can go ahead. Members are encouraged to shout it from the roof tops, share our Facebook page, like the event and tag away. A5 flyers will be made available at Thie Ellyn from next week. Please pop them up in your place of work etc, thank you.

Number of exhibits for each person is a maximum of 6 (2D or 3D) with a maximum of 4 in any class. So, for example, you could submit 4 paintings and 2 ceramics, or the other way round. All items must be labeled and of excellent condition, ready to hang. Please read the terms and conditions on the submission form for clarity.

Handing in is on Saturday 21st August between 12noon - 2pm at Braddan Church. Entrance to the car park is off Saddle Road and entrance to the hall is via the New Hall – signs will be out to direct you.

The exhibition is open to the public for 6 full days as follows:

Wednesday 25th August - 10am - 5pm

Thursday 26th August - 10am - 8pm (late night opening)

Friday 27th - Monday 30th August - 10am - 5pm * 5.15 – 6.30pm collection of **SOLD** items *

Tuesday 31st August 9.00-10.30 * Members collect **unsold** items *

We need your help to make this event a success so please note the opening times above and indicate when you would be able to help man the sales tables / raffle table. You can either drop me an email or message/text, or fill in the rota that is in Thie Ellyn. We need help setting up and clearing away too – the more hands helping the better.

Craft / Sale Tables – 6ft tables will be available this year and must be manned by you during opening times of the exhibition. You can share a table with another if you wish. All items for sale on your table should be made by you. Space is limited so contact Linda Quirk to reserve your table. Cost of a table is £20 for the duration and payable by 1st August 2021 (including form to Linda Q).
