## Rules for Easter Exhibition 2023

### HANDING IN – Monday 3rd April 2023 3-6pm VILLA MARINA ARCADE, DOUGLAS

1. The Exhibition is open to members of 3 months standing whose annual subscription is fully paid.
2. Each member may submit up to **SIX** exhibits either 2D, 3D or a mixture. Note – you cannot enter 6 paintings nor can you enter 6 ceramics. It has to be max of 4 in any class. An exhibit must be an original work of art, not a copy nor print (linocut exempt), and not previously exhibited or for sale elsewhere, either in whole or part.
3. 50% of each exhibitor's works must be for sale. Exhibits not for sale must be labelled "Not For Sale" (N.F.S.) and also indicated on the submission form.
4. A hanging fee of **£2.50 per exhibit** is payable to the Society on Handing-in-day.
5. A commission of **17.5%** will be taken by the Society on the price of each exhibit sold.
6. Artists **must not** alter nor add to their submission after handing in unless authorised by the Secretary.
7. Differences in narrative or price between the label & signed form, the signed form will be considered true.
8. The Society accepts no responsibility for loss or damage however occasioned. Please insure privately.
9. To absolve the Society from any responsibility or liability for infringements of copyright, exhibitors must sign the Declaration on the Entry Form that each and every exhibit is the original work of that member who will be solely liable should any such claim arise.
10. All pictures must be dry when submitted. All must be conventionally framed with the exception of 'square edge' canvases which will be accepted without frames but must have tidy edges. All pictures must be submitted with hanging cords tautly attached. All 'square edge' canvas work must have proper hanging cords tautly stretched on the inside of the frames. Frames and cording must be secure and in good clean condition. Entries contravening any of the above conditions **will not be hung** & fees will not be reimbursed.
11. To each framed exhibit please affix a tie-on label with string long enough to allow the label to hang over the top **CENTER** of the frame or edge. Please do not attach the label to either end of the hanging cord – eg on the screwlet or hook. The hanging cord with the label on the end must be attached to the middle and be able to be flipped to the front (half way down your painting) when checking details.
12. Non hanging exhibits (3D) must also have tie-on labels firmly attached.
13. Complete the Entry Form in BLOCK LETTERS with your name, email address and telephone number, and repeat on the label. There is no need to write down your postal address. Read and sign the Declaration on page 1 of this form and deliver together with your exhibits and entry fee to **VILLA MARINA ARCADE.**
14. Exhibits must remain in the custody of the Committee until the Exhibition closes unless sold and permitted by the Committee to be removed. Please **collect unsold exhibits on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> 6.30-7.30pm or Tuesday 11th April between 9am & 10.30.** Uncollected items (after one month) will be donated to charity.
15. The Committee reserves the right to save space, if necessary, by eliminating any entries on the form. The Society reserves the right to exclude any exhibit.
16. Please offer help where you can, be it setting up, hanging, manning the raffle or sale table.
